CASE SUBMISSIONS CAN EARN YOUR CHAPTER \$500

The [ACRP Chapter Affiliation Standards & Expectations \(CASE\)](#) are a set of performance guidelines designed to help chapters deliver consistent benefits to members. CASE submissions are required by January 31, 2016.

The [CASE Planning Workbook](#) has been created to help leaders gather and document CASE-related information. The workbook mirrors the online CASE survey. ACRP recommends chapters complete this workbook prior to completing the online CASE submission.

To qualify for the \$500 chapter bonus, chapters must complete the online submission form by January 31st. The following documents are required: 1) 2016 Chapter Board Roster (using the “2016 Chapter Board Roster Template” spreadsheet), 2) 2016 Strategic Plan, and 3) year-end financial results for the period 1/1/2015 – 12/31/2015.
