- Advise ACRP staff about issues of importance to chapters
- Identify and examine future roles for chapters
- Ensure the needs of chapters are recognized by ACRP.

Chapter Webpages Moving to ACRP's Online Community

ACRP will be launching a newly designed website this Fall. As part of the web redesign, chapter webpages hosted on ACRP's current website will be migrated to the <u>Online Community</u> providing chapters more access and control over content. Your chapter will be able to:

- Make content updates directly within community
- Pull membership rosters real-time
- Create and publish upcoming events (event registration, contact hour purchase and registration lists will still come from the global office)
