Mandatory IRS Filing Requirements Deadline May 15

In 1984, ACRP received a group exemption letter (Group) from the IRS. This letter allows subordinate organizations (chapters) to be granted 501(c)(3) status by their participation in the Group, thereby avoiding the necessity of individually filing for exemptions. While a group tax exemption number decreases the amount of paperwork required, all chapters must still obtain a separate Employer Identification Number (EIN) and annually file Form 990 or Form 990N with the IRS. For most chapters this will be May 15, 2017, for the 2016 tax year.
