### What's New at ACRP Presentation

### Chapter Tip of the Month - Programming

When planning chapter events programming and content is vital! Here are some tips to success:

- Be sure your program/event description are **relevant to your audience's current needs**.
- Consider **affordable options** such as lunch gatherings at affordable restaurants, brown bag lunches, sponsorships, or free locations (office space).
- Conduct an **evaluation** after every chapter program to find out what topics participants would like covered in future programs.
- Offer members a **season pass** to attend chapter programs at a reduced rate. Program packages might include more programs for bigger discounts.
- Form a **partnership with related organizations** such as nearby ACRP chapters and universities/colleges/vocational technical schools. Get partners to help you advertise your events and the chapter. Share speakers or other resources.
- Distribute **\$5 off certificates** that can be redeemed for another event. Include an expiration date on the certificate to encourage use.
- Take advantage of your chapters **two (2) complimentary webinar replays or Online Conference Library sessions** from ACRP.
- Offer a **free virtual program** introducing potential members to your chapter.
- Offer some programs during **lunch time** to draw people who cannot attend in the evening.
- Offer variety in **format and scale**.

**Additional Tip:** When establishing registration fees for chapter events, always charge a fee. A registration (however nominal) greatly increases the probability of the attendee showing up for your event. Setting a \$0 registration fee can project the impression that your event has no value. The Northern California Chapter achieves ample success by charging chapter members a \$5 registration fee. Whether \$5 or \$3, a registration fee is a practice your chapter should consider for future events.

ACRP is introducing the ACRP-CP® credential in direct response to rapid evolution in the roles of clinical research professionals. With process and technology innovation driving substantial change in how clinical research is conducted, the need for a more inclusive credential reflective of the diverse nature of the roles professionals play in clinical research conduct has never been greater.
