The new ACRP Certification Exam Preparation Classroom Course provides guidance on how to prepare for an ACRP Certification exam (e.g., CCRA[®], CCRC[®], and CPI[®]) to candidates eligible to take the exam. Familiarize yourself with the format of the exam, tackle example questions, and conduct a personal gap analysis to ensure you are fully primed to earn your ACRP Certification.

- Be able to assess their individual level of readiness by practicing exam questions based on the Detailed Content Outline (DCO) under training conditions (not exam conditions)
